

TERMS OF COMPETITION

XXX. Hungarian Junior Open Championship

August 23-25, 2019 Pannonia Golf & Country Club, Alcsútdoboz

- **Organiser:** Hungarian Golf Federation **Rules:** The Championship will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf approved by R&A Rules Limited, the General Term and Conditions of Competitions and the Conditions of Ranking List Tournaments of the Hungarian Golf Federation, and in accordance with the Local Rules of the Pannonia Golf & Country Club. The competition is an HCP modifier. Date of the competition: August 23-25, 2019 Practice day: August 22, 2019 The venue of the competition: Pannonia Golf & Country Club, 8087 Alcsútdoboz, Máriavölgy Form of play: Stroke play 54 (3x18) holes Entry: Available online on the website of the Hungarian Golf Federation (HGF) **Deadline for entry:** August 20, 2019, 11:59 PM Entry fee: 120 EUR/person The entry fee must be paid to the account of the Hungarian Golf Federation. OTP Bank: 11794008-20511052-00000000 - please enter the name of the player and the title of the championship in the reference box. **Deadline for payment:** Wednesday, August 21, 2019, 2 PM The entry fee includes:
 - the entry fee and competition organizing fee;
 - the green fee for the day before the championship (practicing day) and
 - for the competition days (4 green fee);
 - Snack packages 3 times;
 - Participation in the first competition day's dinner on Friday, 23 August 2019



Entry method: Enter individually at www.hungolf.hu by clicking on the Tournaments menu / Federal Tournaments / Tournament Name / Entry button by filling in the entry form shown here. Entry is valid by paying the entry fee.

All entered players will be added to the list of preliminary starters published on the website of HGF.

- **Entry withdrawal:** Players may withdraw their entry until the deadline indicated above. In this case the full amount of entry fee will be refunded via bank transfer.
- Cut: 78 players are the recommended number for the last competition day based on the gross stroke score, which includes those who are tied. The ratio of gender and main categories ("A", "B") is the same as that of the players in the championship by gender and main category, but at least 10 players/main category/boys and 8 players/main category/girls. In cases of doubt, the Committee will decide. The cut number will be published by the Committee after Day 1. The organiser of the championship can also determine a higher number compared to the recommended number (afterwards).

Participants:All amateur golfers who have a valid EGA HCP are eligible to play.
The maximum number of participants is 144 in total. The Committee will hold a
handicap ballot if the number of entries exceeds limits and will prefer competitors
with lower HCPs.
The Hungarian Golf Association may hold 10 wild cards (within the 144
participants).

HCP limit for the Championship: Age group HCP limits and waiting list HCP limits:

U16-21 Boys:	10.0 (EHCP) – waiting list 15.0 (EHCP)
U16-21 Girls:	12.0 (EHCP) – waiting list 17.0 (EHCP)
U14 Boys:	20.0 (EHCP) – waiting list 24.0 (EHCP)
U14 Girls:	22.0 (EHCP) – waiting list 26.0 (EHCP)
U12 Boys:	24.0 (EHCP) – waiting list 28.0 (EHCP)
U12 Girls:	26.0 (EHCP) – waiting list 30.0 (EHCP)

Entry to the waiting list is allowed dependent on the above limited EHCPs. If the entry list is not full (144 participants), then according to the EHCP orders those in the waiting list will be moved to the entry list. Those who are not moved to the start list, their entry fee will be refunded (HGF will return it within two weeks to the account from which the amount was received).

Prizes and categories: At the Hungarian Junior Open Golf Championship, the Hungarian Golf Federation gives out prizes in the following categories:

The Junior Open Championship prizes may be awarded to any participant according to their category classification.

At the Hungarian Junior Golf Championship, the Hungarian Golf Federation gives out prizes in the following categories:

The boy and girl gross winners of the U12 and U14 age groups receive a special prize.

The Junior Hungarian Championship prizes may be awarded to any Hungarian citizen according to their category classification.

Any player can enter in a higher age category. (For example, a U14 player can enter in U16 category) if he/she meets the HCP limit of the category.

If the number of participants of same-sex individuals in a category ("A" or "B") is less than 5, then only the first place will be awarded.

Double prizing are available at the championship.

Tee boxes:	Category "A"	
	Boys:	from man back tee box (white)
	Girls	from woman back tee box (blue)
	Category "B"	
	Boys:	from man standard tee box (yellow)
	Girls:	from woman standard tee box (red)

Starting is in accordance with the Competition Rules of HGF, depending on the number of participants and the decision of the Committee.

Start list:The first day start list can be viewed the day before the training day (August 22,
2019) from 12 PM in the PC Caddie, and on www.hungolf.hu.

Players starting in the same categories should be divided into the same groups where possible depending on their handicaps.

Competition days:

1st competition day: Friday, August 23, 2019

1st competition day start order: increasing order according to EHCP, possibly by category.



2nd completion day: Saturday, August 24, 2019

2nd competition day start order: increasing order according to the previous day stroke results, possibly by category.

3rd competition day: Sunday, August 25, 2019

3rd competition day start order: according to the previous two daily total stroke results, in descending order according to the Championship Rules. The last groups must be set up so that the players of the different categories who are likely to win will start last.

Award Ceremony.

- **Decision of tie:** According to Section 25 of the General Term and Conditions of Competitions.
- Pace of play: According to Section 17 of the General Term and Conditions of Competitions.
- Score cards: The scorecard must be signed by the player and the marker and dropped off at the scoring area as soon as possible after the game has been completed. If the player has dropped off the scorecard or left the scoring area, he will no longer be able to modify or amend it.
- Award Ceremony: Once the event declared completed all score cards have been returned and data are processed
- Caddies: Use of caddies is not permitted
- **Golf cart:** Use of golf carts is not permitted.

Use of distance measuring device: The use of a distance measuring device is permitted, if used only for distance measurement, other supplementary measurements (slope, wind speed, etc.) are not allowed.

Motorised trolleys: Motorised trolley use is allowed.
