31. Hungarian Junior Open Championship

October 9-11, 2020

Organiser: Hungarian Golf Federation

Rules: The Championship will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf approved by R&A Rules Limited, the General Term and Conditions of Competitions and the Conditions of Ranking List Tournaments of the Hungarian Golf Federation, and in accordance with the Local Rules of the Pannonia Golf & Country Club. The competition is an HCP modifier.

Date of the competition: **October 9-11, 2020**

Practice day: **October 8, 2020**

The venue of the competition: **Pannonia Golf & Country Club, 8087 Alcsútdoboz,
Máriavölgy**

Form of play: **Stroke play 54 (3x18) holes**

Entry: **Available online on the website of the Hungarian Golf Federation**

Deadline for entry: **October 5, 2020, 23:59PM**

Entry fee: **150 EUR/person**

Deadline for payment: **October 6., 2020, 12:00**

The entry fee includes:

- the entry fee and competition fee;
- the green fee for the day before the championship (practicing day) and for the competition days (4 green fees);
- Snack packages, water on the days of the competition;
- Participation on dinner on 10 October 2020.



Entry method: Please fill out the Entry form (you can find below *on page 6*).

Entry withdrawal: Players may withdraw their entry until the deadline indicated above. In this case the full amount of entry fee will be refunded via bank transfer.

Cut: 78 players are the recommended number for the last competition day. In case of the cut the ratio of gender is the same as that of the players in the championship by gender.

Participants: All amateur golfers who have a valid EGA or WHS HCP are eligible to play. **The maximum number of participants is 138 in total.** The Committee will hold a handicap ballot if the number of entries exceeds limits and will prefer competitors with lower HCPs. The Hungarian Golf Association may hold 5 wild cards (within the 138 participants).

HCP limit for the Championship:

Age group HCP (in case of WHS is the same as in case of EHCP) Limits and waiting list HCP limits:

U16-21 Boys:	12.0 (EHCP) – waiting list 15.0 (EHCP)
U16-21 Girls:	14.0 (EHCP) – waiting list 17.0 (EHCP)
U14 Boys:	20.0 (EHCP) – waiting list 24.0 (EHCP)
U14 Girls:	22.0 (EHCP) – waiting list 26.0 (EHCP)
U12 Boys:	24.0 (EHCP) – waiting list 28.0 (EHCP)
U12 Girls:	26.0 (EHCP) – waiting list 30.0 (EHCP)

Entry to the waiting list is allowed dependent on the above limited EHCPs. If the entry list is not full (138 participants), then according to the EHCP orders those in the waiting list will be moved to the entry list. Those who are not moved to the start list, their entry fee will be fully refunded (HGF will return it within two weeks to the account from which the amount was received).

Committee: Championship director, 2 referees and the representative from the golf club

Referees: 2 or 3 referees published on the dashboard in the club house. It is the player's responsibility to know the Terms and Conditions of the championship. The Committee's decision is final and cannot be appealed against.

The boy and girl gross winners of the U12 and U14 age groups receive a special prize.

Any player can enter in a higher age category. (For example, a U14 player can enter in U16 category) if he/she meets the HCP limit of the category.

WAGR points can be reached for the participants in Junior Open U18 and U21 category. Players of any age can participate in U18/U21 category but must play from the tee boxes of the chosen category.

Please indicate this intention when registering.

If the number of participants of same-gender individuals in category ("A" or "B") is less than 5, then only the first place will be awarded.



Tee boxes:	<u>Category “A”</u>	
	Boys:	from man back tee box (gold)
	Girls	from woman back tee box (blue)
	<u>Category “B”</u>	
	Boys:	from man standard tee box (yellow)
	Girls:	from woman standard tee box (red)

Starting is in accordance with the Competition Rules of HGF, depending on the number of participants and the decision of the Committee.

Start list: The first day start list can be viewed the day before the training day (October 8, 2020) from 12 PM in the PC Caddie, and on www.hungolf.hu.

Players starting in the same categories should be divided into the same groups where possible depending on their handicaps.

Championship program:

Practice day: *Thursday, October 8, 2020*

Competition days:

1st day of the competition: *Friday, October 9, 2020*

1st competition day start order: increasing order according to EHCP, possibly by category.

2nd day of the competition: *Saturday, October 10, 2020*

2nd competition day start order: increasing order according to the previous day stroke results, possibly by category.

3rd day of the competition: *Sunday, October 11, 2020*

3rd competition day start order: according to the previous two daily total stroke results, in descending order according to the Championship Rules. The last groups must be set up so that the players of the “A” category who are likely to win will start last.

Award Ceremony.



- Decision of tie:** According to Section 20 of the General Term and Conditions of Competitions.
- Pace of play:** According to 1st Supplement of the General Term and Conditions of Competitions.
- Score cards:** The scorecard must be signed by the player and the marker and dropped off at the scoring area as soon as possible after the game has been completed. If the player has dropped off the scorecard or left the scoring area, he will no longer be able to modify or amend it.
- Award Ceremony:** Once the event declared completed – all score cards have been returned and data are processed
- Caddies:** **Use of caddies is not permitted**
- Golf cart:** Use of golf carts is not permitted.
- Use of distance measuring device:** The use of a distance measuring device is permitted.
- Motorised trolleys:** Motorised trolley use is allowed.
